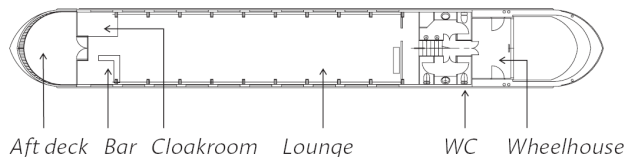

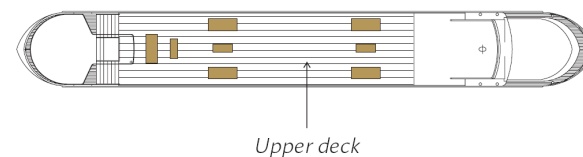

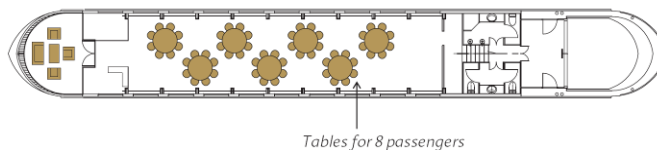

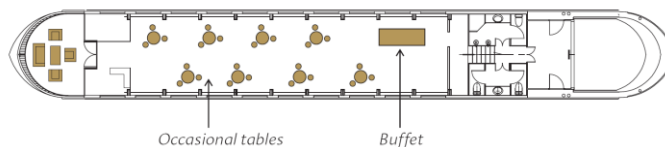
Example of seating plan

COCKTAIL up to 90 pers.

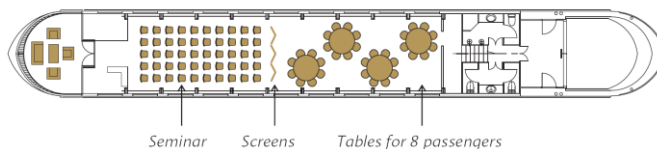
Example of seating plan
